'Little Brother' Gets Big Family

Barry Faklis, 13, acquired a Big Brother yesterday.

He also acquired six smaller brothers and sisters, although he met only four of them.

The acquisition was celebrated with a sail in Mission Bay aboard the 21-foot Light ning sailboat of Barry's new Big Brother, Richard J. Barnes of 4912 Mt. Elbrus St.

A good time was had by Big Brother Barnes, Little Brother Barry and the four other brothers and sisters, who are Barnes' children. Mayor Dail and the county Board of Supervisors have declared today, Father's Day as Big Brother Sunday.

Under the Big Brother movement, fatherless boys and men who are willing to provide them with adult male companionship are paired on a one man-one boy basis, but occasionally a "little brother" is integrated into a family group. Such is the case with Barry and the Barnes family.

Although he has six children of his own, Barnes, a Navy petty officer, volunteered to give a couple of hours a week to a fatherless boy.

For his first meeting with Barry, he brought along his daughter Irene, 11; twins Patricia and Mike, 8, and Roberta, 6. Two younger children were left home.

Irene helped Barry put his life preserver on before the sail began. Then everyone took turns steering the boat, handling the sheets and the like.

Barnes said Barry later will get a chance to help chip and scrape and paint and do the other maintenance chores aboard the boat.

Big Brothers is nonsectarian, nonprofit and interracial. It recruits Big Brothers from all walks of life, married and single.
